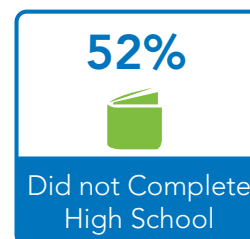
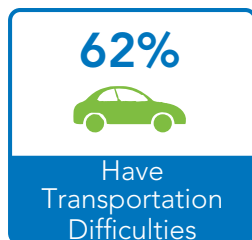
2016-2017: A YEAR IN NUMBERS



For over a decade, OhioGuidestone’s Workforce 360° programming has been providing pathways to success to youth and adults struggling with chronic poverty and overwhelming barriers. The individuals we serve face incredible obstacles to achieving success, including a lack of education, homelessness, mental health issues, and young parenthood. Workforce 360°’s comprehensive programming provides supportive services focused on removing barriers to employment. Our programming gives participants the strength they need to change their own lives, improve their family income, and achieve self-sufficiency. Our participants get the support they need to earn an education, find and retain employment, and improve their earning potential. As our participants find and maintain better paying jobs, they are able to provide for themselves and their families with reduced external aid. Workforce 360° programming directly impacts the lives of those we serve by giving them not only the opportunity to move forward in life, but a solid foundation of confidence, education, problem solving skills, and independence they have never before experienced. When participants walk out of our program, they have a newfound sense of stability, and the knowledge that OhioGuidestone is always there to support them on their pathway to growth, achievement, and lifelong success.
